Dear South Middleton School District Families,

<u>Our hope is that this Emergency Remote Learning Plan will never need to be utilized</u>. However, in the event that the South Middleton School District would need to pivot to a short term period of remote learning instruction at any time this school year due to a large number of COVID cases, we want to ensure that we are thoroughly prepared. This document is to provide you with an overview of how that remote instruction would occur for your child if needed.

Our goal is to send our elementary students home with their devices the day before an emergency school closure. However, in the event of an unpredicted school closure, your child's elementary teacher has sent home a packet of asynchronous activities for them to complete. (*Elementary students and parents will be notified if this packet is to be used on an emergency remote learning day or if live instruction will occur*.) As our secondary students already carry their devices back and forth between school and home each day, they will all be able to participate in live instruction on any emergency remote learning day.

Note:

Our Superintendent Mr. James Estep will send out a message to our school community in the event that remote learning must occur. These messages will be sent the evening before those emergency remote learning days whenever possible.

Thank you for your continued support as we work to provide the very best instruction possible to your child in all situations. May we continue to remain patient with one another and show one another grace on behalf of our students.

In grades K-5:

On Emergency Remote Learning Days, all elementary students will attend a live Morning Meeting and receive live direct instruction in reading, mathematics, and one of the four creative arts (art, library, music or physical education) before lunch time.

Following direct instruction, your child's teacher may provide independent reading and/or math assignments to complete at a time that works best for your child.

*Students who receive additional services such as speech and language instruction will receive those services in the afternoon.
